University and polytechnic students from all ASEAN member states will discuss and debate economic, security, cultural and environmental issues, and come to a consensus on how ASEAN can solve them.

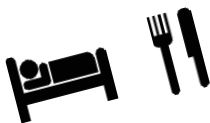
